



General Notice to Masters January 2014

Dry Mixed Recycling (DMR) Trial

As from Monday 27th January Aberdeen Harbour will be providing, on a trial basis, a DMR facility for vessels visiting the port.

The red DMR 1100lt wheelie bins will be sited adjacent to the general waste FEL's bins at the following locations;
Jamison's Quay,
Trinity Quay
Regent Quay 2

The item categories that can be recycled are, **Paper, Cardboard, Plastic, Metal**, the smaller recyclables should be bagged in clear plastic bags before placing in the bin, cardboard should be flattened. More information on these items are shown on the flyer below.

Vessels at other common user areas of the port can arrange through their agent/owner to get their DMR transported to the above locations.

Please note the following items are not suitable for recycling within the bins, glass, food, teabags, crisp wrappers. No additional items should be left on the quayside or adjacent to the bins.

Collection of other non-general waste including special wastes should continue to be arranged through the ships agent.

Please note these facilities are for ships use only.

Owners, Agents and Operators should ensure the contents of this notice is made known to the masters of their vessels.

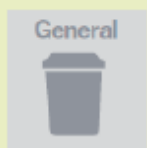
