

Navigation Notice No 15 of 2019

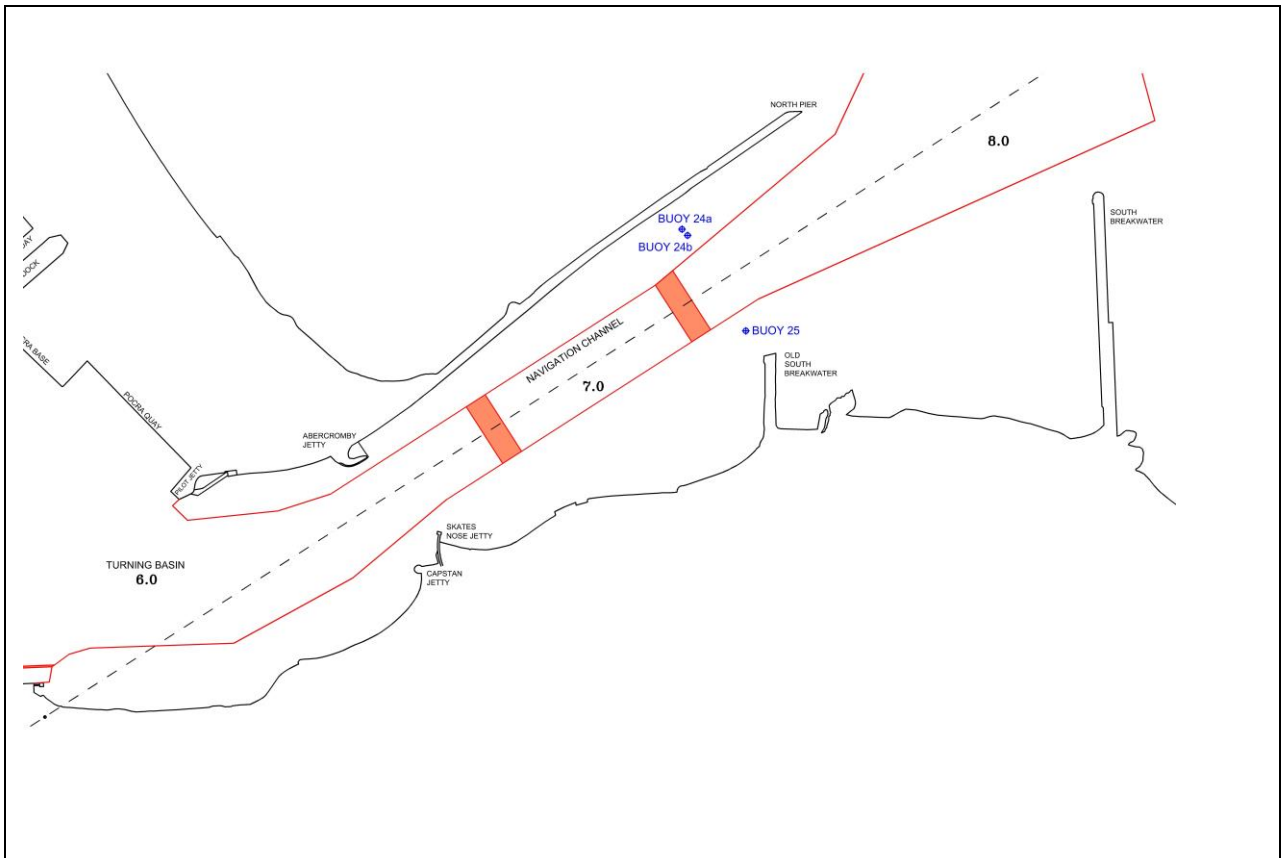
Navigation Channel Smolt receiver buoys

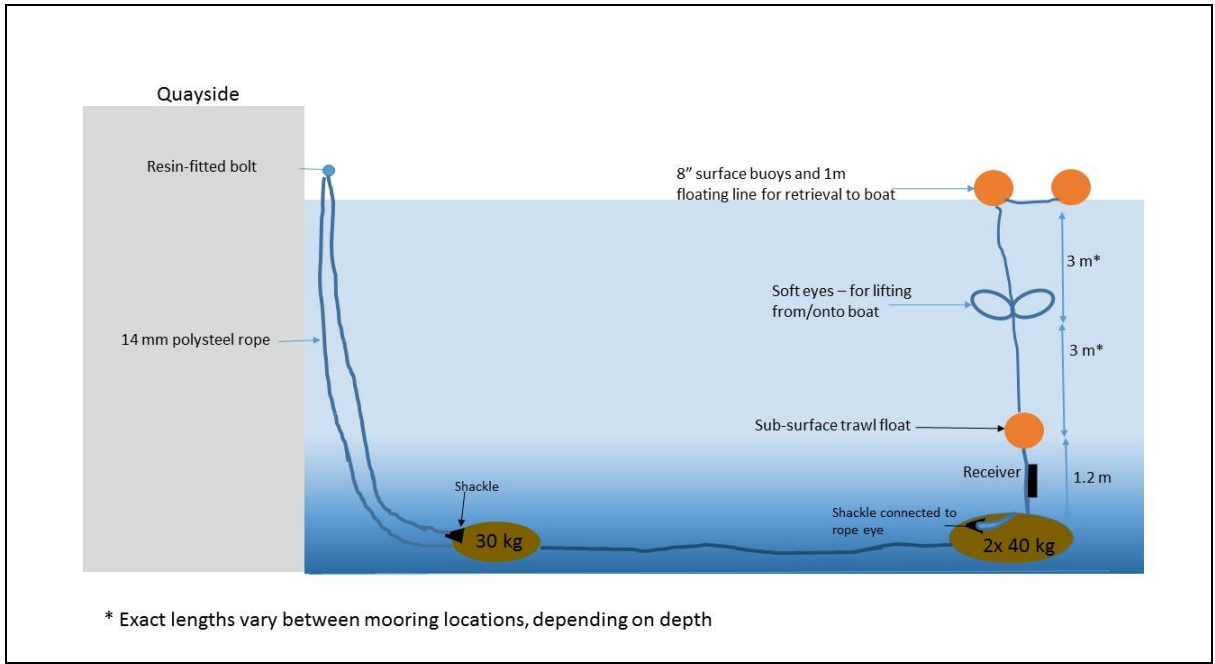
Notice is hereby given that as from 30/04/2019 that 4 Smolt (Juvenile Salmon) receiver buoys have been laid in the harbour out with the navigational channel.

These monitoring buoys are expected to be in place until mid-June. The buoys are secured to the shore with lines.

Masters are reminded to inform their FRCs to transit through the harbour within the channel limits.

Should a buoy be seen out of its approximate position please inform VTS on Ch 12
